5101:2-5-14 Treatment or diagnostic services.

- (A) When a child in out-of-home care has, in addition to routine medical, dental, or vision care, an assessed need for treatment or diagnostic services which are not included in the current case plan, an agency shall inform the person or agency that placed the child of this need.
- (B) If an agency does not directly employ or contract with a vendor for treatment or diagnostic services, the agency shall arrange with the custodial agency or individual for the provision of such services.
- (C) Any treatment or diagnostic services provided to any child pursuant to this rule shall be documented in the child's case record required pursuant to rule 5101:2-5-10 of the Administrative Code.
