5101:3-14-01

"HealthChek" otherwise known as Healthchek: early and periodic screening, diagnosis, and treatment (EPSDT) services program (EPSDT) for individuals under age twenty-one.

- (A) "HealthChek" Healthchek" is Ohio's early and periodic screening, diagnosis, and treatment (EPSDT) program (EPSDT), which EPSDT is a federally-mandated program of comprehensive preventive federally mandated health services available to for medicaid-eligible persons from birth through twenty years of age. The program EPSDT is designed to maintain health by providing early intervention to discover and treat health problems.
- (B) The scope of services provided to an individual depends on the individual's age of the patient, gender, family medical history, ethnic background, and abnormalities encountered during an "HealthChek" or findings of the healthchek (EPSDT) servicescreening or other covered medical service, as specified in Chapter 5101:3-14 of the Administrative Code.
- (C) The "HealthChek" healthchek (EPSDT) program under medicaid includes the following services listed below:
 - (1) Screening services Healthchek screening services which are comprised composed of the components described in rule 5101:3-14-03 of the Administrative Code: and
 - (2) Healthchek diagnosis and treatment services, defined as medically necessary in accordance with rule 5101:3-1-01 of the Administrative Code, are composed of the components described in rule 5101:3-14-05 of the Administrative Code.
 - (2) Vision services as described in Chapter 5101:3-6 of the Administrative Code.
 - (3) Dental services as described in Chapter 5101:3-5 of the Administrative Code.
 - (4) Hearing services as described in rule 5101:3-14-05 of the Administrative Code.
 - (5) Other services which are covered under the medicaid program and are determined by the department to be medically necessary as defined in rule 5101:3-1-01 of the Administrative Code.

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
