5101:3-3-17 **Emergency relocation plan.**

- (A) Each nursing facility (NF) and intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded (ICF-MR) must have a written plan to be followed in the case of an emergency (an explosion, fire, severe weather, or other internal and external disasters) that may require relocation of residents. The plan must be clearly communicated and reviewed with the facility's staff. The plan should include instructions for caring for the residents; notification procedures for contacting physicians, family, guardians and other individuals responsible for the residents; procedures to arrange for transportation, hospitalization, and/or other appropriate services.
- (B) Within one working day of the onset of the emergency, the NF or ICF-MR must notify the resident's family, guardian, sponsor; the county department of job and family services (CDJFS); and the Ohio department of job and family services (ODJFS).
