This rule sets forth policy and procedure governing structural reviews of Ohio department of job and family services-administered waiver service providers, and the provider occurrence process. Differences between the new rule and rescinded rule are non-substantive (just tightening up the language to be more clear), with one exception:

New policy: new non-agency waiver service providers who enter into their first Medicaid provider agreement in accordance with rule 5101:3-1-17.4 of the Administrative Code shall have a face-to-face structural review one, two and three years after the date on which the provider begins furnishing billable waiver services. Upon renewal of the provider agreement, and if the provider has not been substantiated as a violator of a reportable incident, has not been reported for two provider occurrences within a twelve-month period, has not received cumulative overpayments of \$250 or more over a twelve-month period, or does not live with the consumer, he or she will only be subject to a biannual face-to-face structural review.
