5122-29-25 School psychology service.
(A) School psychology services shall:
(1) Include mental health services related to school behavior and learning problems;
(2) Be coordinated with school personnel, as appropriate, in the school setting attended by the person served; and
(3) Be included in the "ISP" with evidence of coordination between and approval of mental health and educational personnel, and in consultation with the person served, and parent or guardian, as appropriate.
(B) Sehool psychology services shall be provided by staff qualified according to paragraph (C) of this rule.
$(C)(B)$ School psychology service shall be provided and supervised by staff who are qualified according to rule 5122-29-30 of the Administrative Code. The following matrix identifies these individuals whe are eligible to provide and supervise the sehool psychology service. Licensed, centified or registered individtals shall eomply with eurrent, applicable seope of practice and supervisory requirements identified by appropriate licensing, certifying or registering bodies:
