## 5122-36-01 Introduction and definitions.

- (A) Introduction: This chapter governs the RSS program. (The Ohio department of job and family services has also adopted rules governing this program, which are primarily located in Chapter 5101:1-17 of the Administrative Code.)
- (B) Definitions for this chapter:
  - (1) "CDJFS" means "county department of job and family services."
  - (2) "Living arrangement" means an arrangement listed under division (C)(1) of section <del>173.355119.69</del> of the Revised Code. "Living arrangement" includes any owner, operator, employee, or volunteer who provides accommodations, supervision, or personal care services in the living arrangement.
  - (3) "ODA" ODMH means "the Ohio department of agingmental health."
  - (4) "ODA's ODMH's designee" has the same meaning as "PASSPORT administrative agency" in section <u>173.355119.69</u> of the Revised Code. The current PASSPORT administrative agencies are the area agencies on aging listed in rule 173-2-04 of the Administrative Code plus "Catholic Social Services of the Miami Valley."
  - (5) "Resident" means an individual who is enrolled in the RSS program.
  - (6) "Residential State Supplement Program" ("RSS program") means the program described under section <del>173.355119.69</del> of the Revised Code.
