Children's Hospitals Quality Outcomes Program.

- (A) "Children's hospital" means an Ohio hospital as defined in section 3727.01 of the Revised Code that is owned and operated by a private entity, is subject to prospective payment as described in rule 5160-2-65 of the Administrative Code, and is excluded from Medicare prospective payments in accordance with 42 C.F.R 412.23(d).
- (B) Children's Hospitals Quality Outcomes Program (CHQP) is a program for children's hospitals established under Section 323.40 of Am. Sub. HB 59 of the 130th General Assembly that encourages children's hospitals to develop quality efforts to reduce harm.
- (C) The Ohio department of medicaid (ODM) shall distribute funds allocated to CHQP to children's hospitals that are actively engaged in the following quality efforts to reduce harm:
- (1) Adverse drug events (ADE)
 - (2) Catheter-associated urinary tract infections (CAUTI)
 - (3) Central line-associated blood stream infections (CLABSI)
 - (4) Injuries from falls and immobility
 - (5) Provider Preventable Readmissions (PPR)
 - (6) Post-Partum visits
 - (7) Surgical site infections
 - (8) Safe Sleep
 - (9) Ventilator-associated pneumonia (VAP)
 - (10) Obstetrical adverse events
 - (11) Venous thromboembolism
 - (12) Serious safety events (SSE)
- (D) Participating children's hospitals will be required to submit documentation to ODM verifying their participation in CHQP's initiative regarding quality efforts to reduce harm as detailed in paragraph (C) of this rule.
- (E) Upon verification by ODM of the children's hospitals participation in the CHQP's initiative regarding quality efforts to reduce harm as detailed in paragraph (C) of

this rule, ODM shall distribute funds under CHQP in the same amount and to the same children's hospitals that received funds in state fiscal year 2013 under Section 309.30.38 of Am. Sub. HB 153 of the 129th General Assembly.
