

## Coordinated Services Program (CSP) Enrollment Criteria

When three or more criteria are met the individual is enrolled in CSP.

Enrollment Criteria	Detailed Description
Individual received four or more abuse potential drugs.	During a 90-day period, an individual received four or more of any combination of any OARRS reportable drugs or any muscle relaxants.
Individual has a history of addiction or drug dependence with abuse potential drugs.	The individual was diagnosed with or treated for addiction within 365 days and during a 90-day period, the individual received any combination of any OARRS reportable drugs or any muscle relaxants.  National diagnosis codes are used to identify addiction and drug dependence.
Individual obtained prescriptions for abuse potential drugs from four or more prescribers.	During a 90-day period, an individual obtained prescribed drugs from four or more prescribers for any combination of any OARRS reportable drugs or any muscle relaxants.  Prescriber identification numbers are used for the determination of multiple prescriber use.
Individual has a poisoning overdose with a benzodiazepine, prescription opioid, or abuse potential drug.	An individual was diagnosed or treated for poisoning overdose within 365 days and during a 90-day period the individual received of any combination of any OARRS reportable drugs or any muscle relaxants.  National diagnosis codes are used to identify poisoning and/or overdose.
Individual utilized four or more pharmacies.	During a 90-day period, an individual utilized four or more pharmacies as determined by national provider identification (NPI) number.
Individual received one narcotic analgesic one benzodiazepine and one muscle relaxant.	During a 90-day period, an individual concurrently received all of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any benzodiazepine</li> <li>• Any muscle relaxant</li> <li>• Any opioid</li> </ul>
