MCOPs are paid per member per month and receive funds to cover required services. ODM must pay MCOPs rates that are actuarially sound, as determined by an outside actuary in accordance with 42 CFR 438.4 and CMS's 2016 Managed Care Rate Setting Consultation Guide. All rates and actuarial methods can be found on the ODM website in Appendix E of the Medicaid MyCare Ohio provider agreement.
