<u>742-20-01</u> Withholding limits on recovery of funds.

- (A) With the exception of the recovery of erroneous payments to alternate payees, which is covered by section 742.64 of the Revised Code, if a person who is a member, former member, contributor, former contributor, retirant, or beneficiary is paid any benefit or payment by Ohio police and fire pension fund (OP&F) to which the person is not entitled, the benefits shall be repaid to OP&F by the person and/or the person's estate. If the person or estate fails to make such repayment, OP&F shall withhold the amount due from any payment due the person or the person's beneficiary under this chapter or may collect the amount in any other manner provided by law.
- (B) Any withholding shall not exceed fifty per cent of the payment due such person.
- (C) This rule is in addition to the payment provisions outlined in rule 742-3-08, 742-3-20 or 742-7-09 of the Administrative Code.
