901:1-9-01 The use of <u>classical swine fever</u>hog cholera biologics.

- (A) The use of any <u>classical swine fever</u> hog cholera serum, inactivated vaccine, living <u>classical swine feverhog cholera</u> vaccine, or <u>classical swine feverhog cholera</u> vaccine which contains any live virus, is prohibited in this state, except that made by a manufacturing plant licensed by the United States Department of Agriculture.
- (B) The use of living <u>classical swine fever hog cholera</u> biologic or <u>classical swine fever hog cholera</u> vaccine which contains any live virus is prohibited in this state, except when used by a licensed veterinarian, and upon written permit issued by the director of agriculture or his authorized representative.
- (C) Any person who shall use or administer any vaccine or product which contains living classical swine feverhog cholera biologic or classical swine feverhog cholera vaccine which contains any live virus within the state shall within five (5) days furnish a report of the use of such vaccine to the Ohio Department of Agriculture.
