901:10-2-07 **Contents of a permit to operate application.**

- (A) Unless otherwise indicated, an application for a permit to operate shall contain the information required in rule <u>PARAGRAPHS</u> (C)(1) AND (C)(2) OF <u>RULE</u> <u>901:10-2-01</u> 901:10-1-02 of the Administrative Code and shall attach all of the following information:
 - (1) A manure management plan that complies with the best management practices set forth in rules 901:10-2-08 to <u>901:10-2-11</u>, <u>901:10-2-13</u> to <u>901:10-2-16</u>901:10-2-14 and 901:10-2-18 of the Administrative Code
 - (2) An insect and rodent control plan that conforms to best management practices and is in accordance with rule 901-10-2-19 of the Administrative Code.
 - (3) A plan for the disposal of dead livestock in accordance with rule 901:10-2-15 of the Administrative Code.<u>A</u> PLAN FOR ODOR MINIMIZATION IN <u>ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 901:10-2-12 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE</u> <u>CODE.</u>
 - (4) An emergency response plan in accordance with rule 901:10-2-17 of the Administrative Code.
- (B) If a biosecurity plan is submitted, it shall be included with the permit to operate application.

(C) THE OWNER OR OPERATOR SHALL MAINTAIN A COPY OF THE CURRENT <u>PERMIT TO OPERATE ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT AT THE</u> <u>CONCENTRATED ANIMAL FEEDING FACILITY'S SITE OFFICE.</u>
