901:10-3-06 Standards of performance for new sources.

- (A) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (B) of this rule, the following standards of performance establish the quantity or quality of effluent that may be discharged by a new concentrated animal feeding facility subject to the provisions of these rules: There shall be no discharge of process wastewater to waters of the state.
- (B) Process wastewater in the overflow may be discharged to waters of the state whenever precipitation events, either chronic or catastrophic, cause an overflow of process wastewater from a concentrated animal feeding operation designed, constructed and operated to contain all process generated waste waters plus the runoff from a twenty-five year, twenty-four hour precipitation event for the location of the point source.
