901:5-58-01 Notice of quarantine.

- (A) To prevent the spread of <u>the destructive pest</u> walnut twig beetle and associated disease known as thousand cankers into the state of Ohio, the states of Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Nevada, <u>North Carolina</u>, New Mexico, <u>Ohio</u>, Oregon, <u>Pennsylvania</u>, Utah, <u>Virginia</u>, Tennessee and Washington are quarantined.
- (B) Under authority of division (B) of section 927.71 of the Revised Code, the director of agriculture may extend a regulated area to include additional portions of a quarantined area either:
 - (1) Upon publication of a notice to that effect in such newspapers in the quarantined area as he may select; or,
 - (2) Upon written notice to those concerned.
- (C) No person shall import or cause to be imported into the state of Ohio or move through the state of Ohio any regulated article listed in rule 901:5-58-03 of the Administrative Code except in accordance with the provisions of rule 901:5-58-05 of the Administrative Code.
