(A) At all times while in operation, every game operated at a fair shall have a sign conspicuously posted that is easily visible to both the player and any prospective player and at no time be obstructed by any object contained in the unit and whieh meets the requirements of paragraph (B) of this rute and states all of the following:
(1) The price of play;
(2) How the game is played; and
(3) Exactly what is required of the player in order to win each prize offered.
(B) At all times while in operation, every game operated at a fair shall have aThe sign required by paragraph (A) above must be professionally printed, non-handwritten and sign comspietrusly posted which meets all of the following requirementsis:
(1) The sign must be atAt least two feet in width;
(2) The sign must be atAt least two feet in length;
(3) The sign metst be permanentlyPermanently affixed to the unit;
(4) All words mttst beare at a minimum of one inch in height; and
(5) Exeept for as described in paragraph (B)(6) of this rule, the sign mutst be professionally printed and may not be handwritten; and
$(6)(5)$ The price of play may be handwritten so long as it is legible, easily read, and at least one inch in height.
(C) The signas required in paragraph(A) of this rule must be easily visible toboth the player and any prospeetive player and at no time be obstrueted by any object contained in the unit.
$(\mathrm{P}) \underline{(\mathrm{C})}$ All trade up games must have the following statement on their sign: "THIS GAME REQUIRES NO MORE THAN THREEFIVE WINS TO WIN ANY PRIZE."
