(A) Guess weight, age, or birth month. The operator of these style games shall ensure:
(1) Operators shall not toueh the patrons.No patrons are touched;
(2) In guessing age, the operator shalthe guess is written down and the guess is within two years of the age-and shallin order to be correct: write the down.
(3) In guessing birth month, the operator shall write down the birth month. Thethe eperator mtastguess is within one month on either side of the patron's actual birth month to be correct-;
(4) In guessing weight, the eperator shall write the-weight is written down and mettst in order to be correct the guess the is within three pounds of either side of the patron's actual weight-; and The
(5) The scale dials shalthave clear figures which shall be-are illuminated at all times in order that they may be read by the public.
(B) Rope ladder game - climb the ladder game. The operator of these style games shall ensure:The
(1) The eperator shall not toteh the ladder is not touched by the operator; and: A safety ehain shall be attached to the ladder at both ends, in addition to the existing ehain or eable and ring, which will aet to hold the ladder in the event the single ehain or eable or ring breaks. The ladder is not to hang loose and must be taut. The ladder must have a thirty-six-ineh fenee or the equivalent on three sides and adequate padding on the deck.
(2) The ladder remains taunt at all times during game play.
(C) Bumper car. The operator of these style games shall ensure:Barriers
(1) Barriers or foul lines shaltare not be-permitted. A starting line only shall be permitted. The ear does not have to hit a backstop to win. The ear shall be eompletely released by the pation. A prize-shall be given every time.Only starting lines are permitted; and
(2) The car does not have to hit a backstop to win; and
(3) The car is completely released by the patron.
(D) Pool game. Pool games shall have pegs so spaced that the total clearance is at least onefourth of an inch greater than the diameter of the ball.
(E) Shuffle boards or alleys. The operator of these style games shall ensure:The
(1) The slide board shallbe-is level laterally and unwarped with no obstructions; and shall be maintained smooth at all times. When numbers are used, they shall be plain, with no blank targets.
(2) The slide board is smooth at all times; and
(3) When numbers are used, they are plain, with no blank targets.
(F) Spoke wheel game. The operator of these style games shall ensure:The
(1) The wheel shall be-is stationary at all times-; and The ball shall have one-and-ene-foutith-ineh elearanee on one side.
(2) The ball has one-and-one-fourth-inch clearance on one side.
(G) Fishing pole or bottle set-up game. The operator of these style games shall ensure:The
(1) The playing surface on which bottles are placed shallis not be-less than twelve inches square for a minimum of one hundred forty-four square inches per square area-; and Bottles shall be placed in the eenter of the playing surface. The playing suface shallbe level at alltimes. The use of grease or wax on rings and playing sufface or bottles is prohibited. The string shall not be more than fiftyfour inehes long and not less than thinty-six inehes long. The pole shall not be fonger than thitity-six inehes and shall not be shorter than twenty-four inehes.
(2) The playing surface is level;
(3) The bottles are placed in the center of the playing surface;
(4) That grease or wax on rings and playing surfaces or bottles is not used;
(5) The string is not more than fifty-four inches long and not less than thirty-six inches long;and
(6) The pole length will measure no longer than thirty-six inches and no shorter than twenty-four inches.
(H) High strikers. The operator of these style games shall ensure:The
(1) The equipment shall be-is in good condition at all times-; The stides or wires shall be straight and free of any obstrution. The slide board shall be plumb at all times. All mallets shall be in good condition. There shall be a fenee of sufficient strength and not less than thirty-six inehes high areund strikers
to protect the public. The fence shall be construeted so a child eannot crawh through. Patrons shall not be permitted to swing the mallet unless both arms are used, but individuals with permanent limb physieal disabilities may use one arm. Only one player shall be permitted at one time to play where adjaeent high strikers are loeated.
(2) The slides or wires are straight and free of any obstruction;
(3) The slide board is plumb at all times:
(4) Patrons are not permitted to swing the mallet unless both arms are used, but individuals with permanent limb physical disabilities may use one arm; and
(5) Only one player will be permitted at one time to play where adjacent high strikers are located.
(I) Skee ball. This game shall be permitted under the following enditionsThe operator of these style games shall ensure:
(1) The use of coin slots or aprons beare permitted-;
(2) The operator mest The score is reset the by a reset device in full view of the participant when operating from an apron:;
(3) The balls shall be-in use are solid, firm, round and not less than three inches in diameter-;
(4) The shall be with where is a minimum clearance of one inch between the ball and ring on all target scoring areas-;
(5) The ball rolling alley surface shall be-is smooth:; and
(6) If any coins are lost due to mechanical failure of machine, the coins will be replaced when reported to the game owner.
(J) In any game at a fair, including the Ohio state fair, where coin-activated games are played, the following shall apply:
(1) The device, when reset, metis done so in full view of the patrons:-:
(2) The operator shall-will replace the patron's money due to mechanical failure of the machine-: and
(3) An attendant mett be is present.
(K) Mirror duck pond. The operator of these style games shall ensure:This
(1) This game shall be-is played for amusement only as defined in paragraph (M) of rule 901:9-2-01 of the Administrative Code-; The water in the pool where the selection is to be made mtrst be kept slow and the object to be seleeted highly visible. This game shall not be operated in the add-up or mateh-up version.
(2) The water in the pool is where the selection is to be made is kept slow:
(3) The object to be selected is highly visible; and
(4) This game is not to be operated in the add-up or match-up version.
(L) Cane rack signage. Each owner of a cane rack shall post a sign eontaining, at a minimem, Minimum signage requirements for all cane racks shall contain the following language: "Canes are to be used as walking sticks only. Any improper use of canes is prohibited and may be cause for removal from the fairgrounds."
(M) Bowler roller game. All trailers must be level.
