The purpose of the hearing is to solicit comment on the following proposed amended rules:

109:2-18-01 **Definitions for CPT Training**

109:2-18-01(D) “Public Appointing Authority” means any agency that appoints a peace officer as defined in divisions (A)(1), (A)(3) to ~~(A)(8)(m)(A)(8)~~, (A)(10), (A)(12), (A)(13), (A)(15) to (A)(18), and (A)(19) of section 109.71 of the Revised Code and the Ohio state highway patrol.

All interested parties are invited to attend the hearing and present oral and/or written testimony.
