## 109:2-7-05 Certification of law enforcement canine units.

109:2-7-05(B) Each canine unit shall be certified every two years—annually by the executive director unless exempted because of unforeseen circumstances such as illness, emergency employment situation, or other valid reasons. The agency employing the canine unit shall submit a written request for exemption from the executive director. If granted by the executive director, the exemption shall be in writing and shall indicate the date by which the canine unit must complete the examination for certification.
