Public Notice of Proposed Changes to the Ohio Fire Code and State Fire Marshal Rules

The Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal (SFM) is considering revisions of specified portions of rules 1301:7-7-01 through 1301:7-7-80 of the Ohio Administrative Code, also collectively known as the Ohio Fire Code (OFC). The purpose of this revision is to make non-substantive editorial changes and grammatical corrections, to correct errors that occurred during the 2017 OFC update filing process, and to make revisions to rules regarding **mobile food units**, as set forth in OFC section 320, and **portable fire extinguishers**, as set forth in OFC section 906.1.

In accordance with this intent and pursuant to Sections 119.03 and 119.032 and Chapters 3731. and 3737. of the Revised Code (R.C.), the State Fire Marshal's Office will conduct a public hearing at **9:30 AM**, on **Monday, November 19, 2018**, at the **Division of State Fire Marshal, 8895 East Main Street, Reynoldsburg, Ohio 43068**. The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment on only the proposed changes to the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code:
