## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND AND HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON COAL MINING RULES AND INDUSTRIAL MINERALS SURFACE MINING RULES

The Chief of the Division of Mineral Resources Management, pursuant to sections 1513.02, 1513.07, 1513.072, 1513.16, 1513.161, 1513.35, 1514.08, 1514.081, and 1514.40 and Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, hereby gives notice of his intention to amend the following coal mining rules and industrial minerals surface mining rules:

## The reasons for amending these rules are the following:

- To comply with the five-year-review requirements of section 106.03 of the Revised Code.
- To correct, in three coal rules, references to Class B and C dams and a technical release document.
- To revise a coal rule regarding the use of a single open-channel spillway.
- To update information in a coal rule regarding Department of Agriculture handbooks 436 and 18.
- To remove a reference to a coal rule that was previously rescinded.
- To be consistent with language usage of other coal rules.
- To make several small corrections and clarifications to the coal rules.

- To update the publication dates of the Code of Federal Regulations and the United States Code of the incorporation by reference rules; and, at the end of each incorporation by reference rule, to update the list of statutes that the rule amplifies.
- To update outdated modes of communication.

A public hearing on the proposed rule amendments will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 5, 2022. This public hearing will be held at Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Assembly Center, 2045 Morse Road, Building E, Columbus, Ohio 43229. At the public hearing, any person affected by the proposed rule amendments may appear and be heard in person, or by the person's attorney, or both, and may present the person's positions, arguments, or contentions, orally or in writing, offer and examine witnesses, and present evidence tending to show that the proposed rule amendments, if adopted, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
