## LEGAL NOTICE

The Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Recreation, pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act and Sections 1541.01, 1541.03, 1541.09 and 1541.19 of the Revised Code hereby declares intent to adopt, amend and rescind administrative rules pertaining to: areas administered as state parks; fees for seasonal, guest and transient docks and tie ups; fees for camping; fees for rental of group building facilities and group camps; fees for rental of cottages; fees for Hocking Hills lodge and swimming pool; fees for storage areas for watercraft, trailers and campers and dry racks storage; fees for special activity permits; fees for rental of recreational vehicles, yurts, tepees, park models, camper cabins and other getaway rentals; fees for Marblehead lighthouse tours; restrictions on removing or disturbing plant and geological features; collection permits for plants and animals; use of flotation devices in state parks; lakes permitting ten horsepower motors; Burr Oak lake horsepower and use restrictions; and Pymatuning lake horsepower and use restrictions.

For such purpose the Division of Parks and Recreation will conduct a public hearing on said proposals on September 17, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. at the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Assembly Center, 2045 Morse Road, Building E (first floor), Columbus, Ohio 43229. At the public hearing, any person affected by the rule changes may appear and be heard in person, or by an attorney, or both, and may present testimony, orally or in writing, offer and examine witnesses, and present evidence tending to show that the rules if adopted will be unreasonable or unlawful.

Such rules are necessary and appropriate for proper management and control of lands and waters administered by the Division of Parks and Recreation and for the protection of
