## NOTICE

Section 119.032 of the Revised Code requires ODA to review rules 173-3-06.2, 173-3-06.3, 173-3-06.4, and 173-3-06.5 of the Administrative Code no later than the rules' assigned review dates. The rules regulate **Chore Services; Home-Maintenance, Home-Modification, and Home-Repair Services; Homemaker Services, and Personal Care,** when those services are provided through a provider agreement using Older Americans Act funds or Alzheimer's Respite Program funds. After its review, ODA is now proposing to amend rules 173-3-06.2, 173-3-06.3, and 173-3-06.4 of the Administrative Code; to rescind rule 173-3-06.5 of the Administrative Code; and to adopt a new rule 173-3-06.5 of the Administrative Code.

ODA will conduct a public hearing to obtain comments concerning the rule proposals on **Tuesday, October 8, 2013** in **Conference Room 9A** which is located just inside the 10<sup>th</sup> floor entrance of ODA's office at **50 W. Broad St.**; **9th Floor; Columbus, OH 43215**. The hearing will begin at **10:30AM** and will continue until all parties in attendance at that time have had an opportunity to provide comment.
