## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

ODA is proposing to implement House Bill 483's language on **criminal records checks** in sections 173.38 and 173.381 of the Revised Code into Chapter 173-9 of the Administrative Code. Specifically, ODA is proposing to rescind rules 173-9-03.1 and 173-9-04.1 of the Administrative Code to adopt new rules of the same number in their stead. ODA is proposing to adopt new rule 173-9-07.1 of the Administrative Code. ODA is also proposing to amend rules 173-9-01, 173-9-02, 173-9-03, 173-9-04, 173-9-05, 173-9-06, 173-9-07, 173-9-08, 173-9-09, and 173-9-10 of the Administrative Code.
