In accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code (R.C.), the Director of the Ohio Department of Health announces a Public Hearing at the date and time listed above to hear comments regarding the following action:

Ohio Revised Code (O.A.C.) Chapter 3701-67 – Alcohol and Drug Testing (OAC 3701-67-01, 3701-67-02, 3701-67-03, 3701-67-04, 3701-67-05, 3701-67-06, 3701-67-07, and 3701-67-08)

The rules in this package set forth the responsibilities of the Department and county or regional child fatality review (CFR) boards to collect and report data pertaining to child deaths.

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3701-67-01 specifies definitions related to the Department's review of child fatalities. OAC 3701-67-01 and 3701-67-03 require each county in Ohio to establish or join a CFR board, prescribe the purpose and meeting responsibilities of CFR boards, and require CFR boards to submit review information in an annual report to the Department. OAC 3701-67-04 requires CFR boards to implement a data collection system for reviewing child deaths and to secure the confidentiality of all information collected by the system for the time period specified by the board's records retention schedule. OAC 3701-67-05 requires CFR board members to attend an annual training program provided by the Department and specifies the educational goals of the program.

OAC 3701-67-06 requires CFR boards to collect specific components of information regarding child fatalities. The rule is amended to require boards to report additional factors, such as whether substance abuse was involved, whether the death was related to the conditions of the child's sleeping environment, and others. OAC 3701-67-07 requires CFR boards to submit the annual report to the Department by April 1st of each year, describing the number of deaths in the county or region and the number of reviews completed by the board, among others. Finally, OAC 3701-67-08 requires the Department to collaborate with the Ohio Children's Trust

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Fund Board to produce an annual report organizing the data collected from the CFR boards by September 30th of each year.

Information regarding rule package proposed:

This rule package consists of seven no-change rules and one amended rule proposed by the Ohio Department of Health (Department) as part of the statutory five-year review process. This rule package was submitted to the CSI Office on December 15, 2021, and the public comment period was held open through January 14, 2022.

Ohio Revised Code (O.A.C.) Chapter 3701-15-03 – Tuberculosis (OAC 3701-15-03)

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3701-15-03 establishes tuberculosis standards referenced by ODH. The rule includes references to core curriculum, treatment standards, and prevention guidelines. The rule is being amended to reflect updates to the referenced materials.

Information regarding rule package proposed:

This rule package consists of one amended rule proposed by the Ohio Department of Health (ODH). This rule package was submitted to the CSI Office on January 10, 2020, and the public comment period was held open through February 10, 2020.
