In accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code (R.C.) and by authority of R.C. 3717.05, the Directors of the Departments of Health and Agriculture jointly propose amendments to thirteen Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.) rules from the **Ohio Uniform Food Safety Code** Chapter. The rules proposed for amendment are:

These rules, along with the other rules in O.A.C. Chapter 3717-1, establish the Uniform Food Safety Code for food service operations and retail food establishments in Ohio. Proposed amendments are a result of the Food and Drug Administration's publishing of the 2011 Supplement to the Model Food Code and the 2013 edition of the Model Food Code. Many of the proposed changes are minor; however, some substantive changes are proposed, including the requirement that food service operations and retail food establishments appoint at least one employee with supervisory responsibility to be a certified food protection manager.

Previously Announced Rules on Agenda:

Besides the Ohio Food Safety Code rules, other rules that will be considered on the September 30th agenda are from the following Administrative Code Chapters: 3701:1-37 (Physical Protection of Category One and Category Two Quantities of Radioactive Material); 3701:1-46 (General Licenses and Licenses for Manufacturing and Distribution; and 3701-69 (Radon Testing and Mitigation Activities).

Hearing and Comment Procedure:

At the hearing, people affected by the proposed actions may appear and be heard in person, by an attorney or both; may present their positions, arguments, or contentions orally or in writing; may offer witnesses; and may present evidence tending to show that the proposed rules, if adopted or effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
