Public Notice Proposed Rulemaking Governing Storm Water Program

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Section 6111.041 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code, proposes to adopt amendments to the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code:

Chapter 3745-39 of the Administrative Code addresses permitting requirements for storm water discharges from construction sites, certain industries, and urban areas. The first three rules in OAC Chapter 3745-39 contain the regulations for small municipal separate storm sewer systems or small MS4s.

The amended rules include updated citations, grammatical edits and formatting revisions, and clarify the exclusion for fire fighting activities in rule 3745-39-03 to reflect existing practice.

The public comment period will run until **5:00 p.m. on August 4, 2009.** A public hearing on these proposed rule amendments will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. This hearing will be held in **Conference Room B** at the Ohio EPA Central Office, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio at 2:00 p.m. on August 4, 2009.

Oral testimony may be limited to five minutes, depending on the number of persons testifying. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and to present oral and/or written comments concerning the proposed rules. Division of Surface Water, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus Ohio 43216-1049. Written comments may also be submitted to the Hearing Officer at the public hearing. Written testimony will receive the same consideration as oral testimony. All testimony received at the hearing or by **5:00 p.m. on August 4, 2009**, will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rulemaking. Written comments submitted after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit.
