NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Building Standards will convene for a public hearing in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, at 10:00 A.M., Friday, March 30, 2007 in Hearing Room #1, at 6606 Tussing Road, Reynoldsburg, Ohio. The purpose of the hearing is to consider rules of the Administrative Code, identified as Amendments Group LXXVI of the Ohio Building Codes, proposed pursuant to Chapters 119., 3781., 3791., and 4104. of the Revised Code.

Synopsis of the proposed rules:

PART A

Consider the following new rule of the Administrative Code certifying building departments to enforce of the Residential Code of Ohio: 4101:2-80-02. PART B

PART C

Consider proposed new miscellaneous rule 4101:2-93-13 which is to provide an administrative remedy to revoke or suspend an electrical safety inspector's certification given just cause.

PART D

Consider proposed changes to new Ohio Building Code rule 4101:1-1-01 of Amendments Group LXXIV which was re-filed as a result of SB 305 which was recently enacted by the legislature.

PART E

Consider proposed changes to new Ohio Plumbing Code rules 4101:3-3-01, 4101:3-7-01, and 4101:3-10-01 of Amendments Group LXXIV which were re-filed as a result of SB 305 which was recently enacted by the legislature.
