Pursuant to an R.C. 119.032 administrative rule review, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of soliciting comment on the following proposed changes to Chapter 4501:1-7, "Vehicle Registration," of the Ohio Administrative Code:

Amendments

4501:1-7-04 (Registration and titling of all-purpose vehicles and off-highway motorcycles) Paragraph (A) is amended to add an effective date; 4501:1-7-14 (Collector's Vehicles) Paragraph (D) has been revised to clarify that a collector's vehicle may not be used as a principal means of transportation; 4501:1-7-13 (Special plates for reservists, veterans, and active duty personnel) – Paragraph (P) is amended to provide that the Registrar, with the assistance of the Department of Veteran Services and the Institute of Heraldry, shall design the special plates for reservists, veterans, and active duty personnel.

Any persons affected by the proposed amendments to these rules may appear at the hearing and be heard in person, or by an attorney, or both, or may present their position, argument, or contention in writing. Persons may offer and examine witnesses and present evidence to show that the proposed changes will be unreasonable or unlawful.
