The Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code, will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of soliciting comments regarding the adoption, amendment and recession of rules.

The public hearing will be conducted on **Tuesday, January 3, 2017** beginning at **9:00 a.m.** in Room 1108, located at the Ohio Department of Public Safety, 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus, OH 43223 and continue until all parties in attendance have had an opportunity to be heard.

The following rules are proposed for amendment to clarify and establish requirements:

- 4501:1-7-01 Application for special license plates issued to volunteer firefighters.
- 4501:1-7-02 Conditions for issuance of license plates, removable windshield placards and temporary removable windshield placards for persons with disabilities.
- 4501:1-7-08 Vehicle registration renewal by electronic means.
- 4501:1-7-11 Specification for all-purpose vehicle decal.
- 4501:1-7-12 Special plates for national guard members.
- 4501:1-7-13 Special plates for reservists, veterans and active duty personnel.

- 4501:1-8-12 Credits for unused portion of vehicle registration.

The following rule is newly proposed to clarify and establish requirements:

- 4501:1-7-15 Materials incorporated by reference.

Persons affected by the proposed rules may appear at the hearing and be heard in person, or by an attorney, or both, or may present their position, argument, or contention in writing. Persons may offer and examine witnesses and present evidence to show that the proposed rules will be unreasonable or unlawful if enacted.
