

NOTIFICATION OF PUBLIC HEARING
Notice of hearing to amend Rule 4501:1-7-13
Of the Ohio Administrative Code in accordance with
Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code

Notice is hereby given that a hearing will be held by the Registrar of the Bureau of Motor Vehicles division of the Ohio Department of Public Safety for the purpose of considering amendment of the above-listed proposed administrative rule.

As authorized in Sections 4501.02, 4503.48, 4503.53, and 4503.54 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Registrar of the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) has proposed to amend Rule 4501:1-7-13 of the Ohio Administrative Code regarding special license plates for reservists and veterans, and persons on active duty in a branch of the armed forces of the United States. Because the United States armed forces identification cards are no longer required to indicate military status, the proposed rule change is to remove United States armed forces identification cards as a form of proof of military status recognized by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles in issuing special license plates for persons on active duty in a branch of the armed forces of the United States.

A public hearing on the proposed rule will be held Monday, July 10, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. in room 109 (first floor) of the Charles D. Shipley Building, Ohio Department of Public Safety, 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.

Either written or oral testimony will be received at the hearing. Additionally, written comments received at the address below before the hearing will be treated as testimony.
