

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO AMEND OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE 4501:1-1-21 PRESCRIBING ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS

The Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, will hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering amendments to administrative rule 4501:1-1-21 governing acceptable identification documents. The purpose of the rule amendments is to allow acceptance of identification documents issued by the Ohio Department of Youth Services and the acceptance of Ohio driver's licenses, commercial driver's licenses (CDLs), and Ohio identification cards as evidence of a person's identification.

The hearing will be held on Friday, December 21, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 109, Shipley Ohio Department of Public Safety Building, 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.

Any person may attend in person or through counsel and may give written or oral testimony. In addition, the Bureau of Motor Vehicles will accept written comments received at the address below prior to the date of the hearing.
