

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
to rescind rule 4501:1-1-21,
and to adopt new rule 4501:1-1-21
of the Ohio Administrative Code in accordance with
Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code

The Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, will conduct a public hearing pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (R.C.) 119.02 through 119.04 on August 26, 2009 at 11:00 a.m. at the Ohio Department of Public Safety, 1970 West Broad Street, Room 109, Columbus, Ohio. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public comment on new rule 4501:1-1-21 governing acceptable documents to be presented when applying for a temporary permit, driver's license, commercial driver's license (CDL), motorcycle operator's license, or state identification (ID) card.

The Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, proposes to rescind current rule 4501:1-1-21, and to adopt new rule 4501:1-1-21 of the Ohio Administrative Code. The proposed rule sets forth lists of primary and secondary documents acceptable as evidence of the applicant's identity, defines the requirements for establishing the applicant's full legal name, specifies the requirements for establishing the applicant's date of birth and social security number, specifies the requirements for establishing the applicant's legal presence in the United States, and specifies the requirements for establishing the applicant's resident street address within the state of Ohio. The proposed rule also clarifies the requirements for a social security number, specifies the documents needed to apply for a duplicate temporary permit, driver's license, CDL, motorcycle operator's license, or state ID card, and permits the registrar of motor vehicles to issue directives to add documents to, or delete documents from, the acceptable documents lists for good cause pending amendments to the rule.

Either written or oral testimony will be received at the hearing. Additionally, written comments received at the address below before the hearing will be treated as testimony.
