The Ohio Department of Public Safety, Driver Training Section, pursuant to Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code, will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of soliciting comments regarding the adoption, amendment and recession of rules.

The public hearing will be conducted on **Monday, March 7, 2022** beginning at **9:30 a.m.**, and continue until all parties in attendance have had an opportunity to be heard.
