

November 2017 Proposed Rules--Request For Comments

Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Sections 107.62 and 121.82 require state agencies, including the Ohio Board of Nursing, to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined ORC Section 107.52), and provide opportunity for those persons affected by the rules to provide input.

At this time, the Board welcomes further comment on the following rules that have been forwarded to Ohio's Common Sense Initiative Office (CSI) for review: The Board proposes to amend, or file no change rules following the five-year rule review for Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapters 4723-1, Board Organization and Records; 4723-3, Definitions; and 4723-14, Continuing Education. The Board further proposes to otherwise amend individual rules 4723-2-03; 4723-7-09; 4723-8-01 through 4723-8-05 and 4723-8-07 through 4723-8-10; 4723-9-01 through 4723-9-12; 4723-23-01 and 4723-23-08, that are found within OAC Chapters related to Licensing for Active Duty Military and Veterans; Examination and Licensure; Advanced Practice Registered Nurse Certification and Practice; Prescriptive Authority; and Dialysis Technicians, respectively.
