NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Ohio Board of Nursing will hold a public hearing on November 28, 2018 beginning at 1:00 p.m. at the Ohio Board of Nursing hearing room, located at 17 South High Street, Suite 660, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3466, for the purpose of amending rules following the five-year rule review for Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapters:

- 4723-4, Standards of Practice Relative to RN or LPN
- 4723-6, Alternative Program for Chemical Dependency/Substance Use Disorder Monitoring
- 4723-18, Practice Intervention and Improvement Program (PIIP)
- 4723-20, Prevention of Disease Transmission

The Board further proposes to otherwise amend individual rules: 4723-5-08, 4723-7-04, 4723-7-05, 4723-7-06, 4723-7-10. The Board proposes to adopt new rule 4723-9-13 to establish standards for medication-assisted treatment for substance use disorders.

Any person affected by the proposed action may present oral or written testimony. All interested persons will be given the opportunity to be heard at the public hearing. Those persons who wish to provide oral testimony at the hearing are encouraged to inform the Board prior to the hearing date and may be given preference in the order of testimony. Written comments received by the Board before the close of the hearing record will be considered. Written comments in lieu of oral testimony may be submitted by bringing the testimony to the public hearing, submitting via e-mail to rules@nursing.ohio.gov or by mail to be received by the close of hearing to the attention of:
