Greetings Stakeholders,

The Ohio Board of Nursing will hold a public hearing on **Thursday, November 2, 2023, beginning at 2:00 p.m.** at the Vern Riffe Center for Government and the Arts, located at 77 S. High Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215, Room 1918 -19th floor. The Board proposes to amend, rescind or file no changes to rules, following the five-year rule review process for the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). The Board also proposes to amend rules not subject to the five-year review process as well as to adopt new rules and rescind rules in the following chapters. The proposed changes have been published several times including most recently when they were filed with the Common Sense Initiative.
