In accordance with Ohio Administrative Code Section 4734-2-01, any person affected by the rules may:

- Appear and be heard in person, by the person's attorney, or both via the hearing on August 17, 2020;
- Present their positions, arguments, or contentions, orally or in writing;
- Offer and examine witnesses;
- Present evidence tending to show that the proposed rules, if adopted, would be unreasonable or unlawful.

The Board will also permit persons affected by the proposed rules actions to present their positions, arguments, or contentions in writing. Written testimony must be received in the Board office by August 17, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. to be included in the hearing record. You are not required to appear at the hearing if you choose to submit written testimony.

Upon closure of the hearing record, the Board will thoroughly review and consider all testimony. The Board may make changes to a rule based on testimony received. If the Board refiles a rule, a second public hearing notice is not required unless the change in the rule makes the rule inconsistent with the public hearing notice provided with the original rule filing.
