In accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code (R.C.) and by authority of R.C. 4747.04, the Ohio Hearing Aid Dealers and Fitters Licensing Board proposes changes to the following nine rules:

Amendments of note 1) add definitions of “supervision,” and “mail”; 2) designate two additional months in which a required annual meeting may take place; and add the possibility of electronic applications through the eLicense system.

## Procedure and Public Comment:

At the hearing, people affected by the proposed actions may appear and be heard in person, by an attorney or both; may present their positions, arguments, or contentions orally or in writing; may offer witnesses; and may present evidence tending to show that the proposed rules, if adopted or effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful. To aid in getting visitors through building security, both persons intending to testify at the hearing and those simply intending to observe are encouraged to pre-register by writing to the Hearing Aid Dealers and Fitters Licensing Board, 246 North High Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215, or by e-mail to [Hearing@odh.ohio.gov](mailto:Hearing@odh.ohio.gov). Also, visitors must have a state issued ID card, and be aware that no backpacks are allowed in the building.
