The Ohio Department of Public Safety, State Board of Emergency Medical, Fire, and Transportation Services, pursuant to Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code, will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of soliciting comments regarding the adoption, amendment and rescission of rules.

The following rules are proposed for amendment:

- 4766-10-05 Report of administrative actions.
- 4765-14-01 Definitions
- 4765-14-02 Determination of a trauma victim.
- 4766-14-05 Expectations to mandatory transport.

Persons affected by the proposed rules may appear at the hearing and be heard in person, or by an attorney, or both, or may present their position, argument, or contention in writing. Persons may offer and examine witnesses and present evidence to show that the proposed rules will be unreasonable or unlawful if enacted.
