The following rule is proposed for amendment to state in rule existing policy that makes successfully completed written and practical portions of examinations for those seeking to be certified or seeking renewal of a certificate to practice as an EMR, EMT, AEMT, or paramedic valid for one year from the date of completion:

4765-8-05 Examinations.

Persons affected by the proposed rule may appear at the hearing and be heard in person, or by an attorney, or both, or may present their position, argument, or contention in writing. Persons may offer and examine witnesses and present evidence to show that the proposed rule will be unreasonable or unlawful if enacted.
