Pursuant to sections 5101.02, 5101.49, 5101.80, 5107.02, 5107.05, 5107.71, 5107.711, 5107.712, 5107.713, 5107.714, 5107.715, 5107.716, 5107.717, 5115.03, 5115.05, and Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the adoption, amendment, and rescission of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101: 1-1-13, entitled Assistance group records, is being proposed for rescission due to five year review. This rule sets forth provisions regarding assistance group records for the cash assistance programs. The rule is being replaced by new rule 5101:1-1-13.

Rule 5101:1-1-13, entitled Assistance group records, case records, retention and transfer of records, is being proposed for adoption due to five year review. This rule sets forth guidelines to address the composition, retention and transfer of records between county agencies. This rule replaces rules 5101:1-1-13 and 5101:1-1-14.

Rule 5101:1-1-14, entitled Intercounty transfers, is being proposed for rescission due to five year review. This rule sets forth processes for the transfer of cash assistance information between county agencies. The rule is being replaced by new rule 5101:1-1-13.

Rule 5101:1-3-01, entitled Ohio works first: federal work participation rates, is being proposed for amendment to add clarifying language to the definition of two-parent assistance group in the Ohio works first program. This rule sets forth policy regarding federally required work participation rates.

Rule 5101:1-3-04, entitled Ohio works first (OWF): temporary absence, is being proposed for rescission due to five year review. This rule sets forth Ohio works first provisions to address the temporary absence of an assistance group member. The rule is being replaced by new rule 5101:1-3-04.

Rule 5101:1-3-04, entitled Ohio works first: temporary absence, is being proposed for adoption. The rule replaces former rule 5101:1-3-04 and sets forth Ohio works first policy to address the temporary absence of an assistance group member.

Rule 5101:1-3-04.1, entitled Ohio works first (OWF): shared parenting (joint custody), is being proposed for rescission due to five year review. This rule sets forth Ohio works first provisions that address shared parenting situations. The rule is being replaced by new rule 5101:1-3-04.1

Rule 5101:1-3-04.1, entitled Ohio works first: shared parenting (joint custody), is being proposed for adoption. The rule replaces former rule 5101:1-3-04.1 and sets forth Ohio works first policy to address shared parenting situations. This rule replaces former rule 5101:1-3-04.1.

Rule 5101:1-3-20, entitled Ohio works first: domestic violence – information, screening, referral and waiver of Ohio works first eligibility requirements, is being proposed for amendment to clarify that the domestic violence brochure is required at initial application for Ohio works first only, and is not required at reapplication. This rule sets forth policy regarding providing information, screening, referral and waiver of Ohio works first eligibility requirements due to domestic violence.
