Pursuant to Section 5107.05 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to amend the rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:1-1-50, entitled Written declaration of citizenship/alien status and the use of the systematic alien verification for entitlements system. This rule is being proposed for amendment as a result of the five year rule review process. References to "CDJFS" have been removed and replaced with "county agency". This rule also has minor language changes to improve clarity. This rule sets forth the policy regarding written declaration for citizenship and alien status of noncitizens who apply for the Ohio works first; prevention, retention and contingency; and refugee cash assistance programs.
