Pursuant to sections 5101.17, 5101.18, 5101.80, 5101.801, 5107.02, 5107.05, 5107.10, 5107.16, 5108.01, 5108.02, 5117.10 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the adoption, amendment, or rescission of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:1-3-01, entitled <u>OWF</u>: definitions of assistance group composition for work <u>participation purposes</u> is being proposed for amendment. The changes to the rule are additions of clarifying language at paragraphs (A) and (A)(2) of the rule regarding two-parent assistance groups and work participation.

Rule 5101:1-23-20, entitled <u>OWF</u>: income and eligibility is being proposed for amendment. The changes to the rule entail the addition of clarifying language in several places within the rule regarding the treatment of income of certain individuals whose needs are not included in the OWF assistance group, but whose income must be considered in determining the eligibility of the OWF assistance group.

Rule 5101:1-24-20, entitled <u>Prevention</u>, retention and contingency (PRC) <u>program: excluded income and resources</u> is being proposed for rescission because it is being replaced by new rule 5101:1-24-20. This rule sets forth the sources and types of excluded income in the prevention, retention and contingency program. Rule 5101:1-24-20, entitled <u>Prevention</u>, retention and contingency (PRC) <u>program: excluded income and resources</u> is being proposed for adoption. It replaces former rule 5101:1-24-20 and sets forth the several additional sources and types of excluded income in the PRC program.
