Pursuant to sections 2151.421, 5101.141, 5103.03, 5153.166 and Chapter 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the adoption, amendment, or rescission of the rule or rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

**OAC 5101:2-42-19**, entitled <u>Requirements for the provision of independent living</u> services to youth in custody is being revised to include federal requirements to instruct youth emancipating from child welfare on how to obtain a health care proxy, power of attorney and health insurance, which should be included in the final transition plan prior to emancipation. In addition, revisions were made in response to stakeholders' request that guidance to youth also include information regarding selective service and credit reports. Other minor grammatical corrections were made.

**OAC 5101:2-42-66.2**, entitled <u>Documentation of comprehensive health care for children</u> <u>in placement</u>, is being revised to reference federal requirements. The changes to the rule include incorporation by reference to OAC 5101:2-42-19. Other referenced rules have been revised within this rule, which governs the documentation of health care for children in placement. Other minor grammatical corrections were made.
