Pursuant to sections 5103.03, 5153.166 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:2-42-18, entitled PCSA and PCPA approval of placements with relative and nonrelative substitute caregivers, is being proposed for amendment in order to align with rule 5101:2-7-02 of the Ohio Administrative Code. This rule sets forth the requirements for completing a home assessment for relative and nonrelative caregivers. The changes include adding paragraph (F) to reference OAC 5101:2-7-02 which state the four prohibitive criminal offenses for all substitute caregivers and deleting the reference to central registry as all searches are now done via SACWIS.

Rule 5101:2-1-01, entitled <u>Children services definitions of terms</u>, is being proposed for amendment in order to clarify some definitions of terms used in placement and foster care rules. This rule sets forth the overall definitions used in Chapters 5101:2-5, 5101:2-7, 5101:2-9, 5101:2-33, 5101:2-35, 5101:2-36, 5101:2-39, 5101:2-40, 5101:2-42, 5101:2-44, 5101:2-47, 5101:2-48, 5101:2-49, 5101:2-52 and 5101:2-57 of the Administrative Code. Changes were made to the following definitions: repeat offender, substitute caregiver, temporary custody by commitment, and variance.
