Pursuant to sections 2151.412, 2151.421, 5103.03, 5153.16 and Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

OAC 5101:2-38-08 <u>Child's education and health information</u> sets forth the requirements that apply to documentation of efforts to maintain a child in the same school the child was attending at the time of placement or reasons why remaining in the same school is not in the child's best interest. This rule is being amended to include language to clarify efforts are made at the time of each placement or placement change.

OAC 5101:2-38-10 <u>Requirements for completing the semiannual administrative</u> <u>review</u> sets forth the requirements that apply to a public children services agency (PCSA) and a private child placing agency (PCPA) for completing the semiannual administrative review. This rule is being proposed for amendment as a result of the Child and Family Services Improvement and Innovation Act. New language is added for PCSAs and PCPAs to provide each child who has attained the age of sixteen a copy of their credit report.
