Pursuant to Sections 5153.112, 5153.122 ,5153.123 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon. These rules are being filed as part of the five year rule review process.

OAC 5101:2-47-11 entitled Reimbursement for Foster Care Maintenance Costs for Children's Residential Centers, Group Homes, Maternity Homes, Residential Parenting Facilities, and Purchased Foster Care Homes. This rule outlines the reimbursement criteria for children who are eligible for FCM. The revision date of the JFS 02911 "Single Cost Report" was changed to July, 2013.

OAC 5101:2-47-26.1 entitled Public Children Services Agencies (PCSA), Private Child Placing Agencies (PCPA), Private Noncustodial Agencies (PNA): Title IV-E Cost Report Filing Requirements, Record Retention Requirements and Related Party Disclosure Requirements. This rule clarifies the cost report filing requirements, the deadlines for filing the cost report, and record retention requirements. In paragraph (B)(1) the reference to the OMB circular A 122 was changed to CFR Part 230 and (B)(2) the reference to OMB circular A 87 was changed to CFR Part 255.

OAC 5101:2-47-26.2 entitled Cost Report "Agreed Upon Procedures" Engagement. This rule outlines the requirement for a private child placing agency (PCPA) or a private noncustodial agency (PNA) that completes a JFS 02911 JFS "Title IV-E Single Cost Report" to have an annual JFS 02913 " Title IV-E Agreed Upon Procedures Engagement" conducted for its cost report. The "Agreed Upon Procedures Engagement" was changed from an appendix to a form.
