OAC 5101:2-42-04 entitled <u>Authority to Assume and Retain Custody of a Child sets</u> forth the requirements upon agency custody and the retention of custody. The JFS 01666 form was revised and the new revision date of the form was amended within the rule. This rule has been amended to format the rule for clarity and minor grammatical changes were made.

OAC 5101:2-42-64 entitled <u>Pre-placement Services</u> sets forth the requirements for the agency to provide or arrange preplacement services to the child and the parent, guardian, or custodian when substitute care placement of the child is to occur. This rule has been amended to format the rule for clarity and minor grammatical changes were made. This rule is being proposed for amendment to adhere to the five year rule review process.

OAC 5101:2-42-65 entitled <u>Requirements for independent living arrangements for independent</u> <u>living youth in custody</u> sets forth the requirements for the PCSAs and PCPAs when placing a youth in its custody in an independent living arrangement. This rule has been amended to format the rule for clarity and revise a cross reference in OAC rules pertaining to the child's case record and minor grammatical changes were made. This rule is being proposed for amendment to adhere to the five year rule review process.

OAC 5101:2-42-66.1 entitled <u>Administrative procedures for comprehensive health care for children in placement</u> sets forth the requirements of comprehensive health care for children in placement between the CDJFS and the PCSAs and PCPAs. This rule has been amended to format the rule for clarity and minor grammatical changes were made. This rule is being proposed for amendment to adhere to the five year rule review process.

OAC 5101:2-42-66.2 entitled <u>Documentation of Comprehensive Health Care for Children In</u> <u>Placement</u> sets forth the requirements to document and maintain in the case record a record of physical health examinations, developmental and psychological assessments, and treatment for each child in the care or custody of a PCSA, PCPA, or PNA. This rule has been amended to format the rule for clarity and minor grammatical changes were made. This rule is being proposed for amendment to adhere to the five year rule review process.

OAC 5101:2-42-70 entitled <u>Provision of Services to Unmarried Minor Parents</u> sets forth the requirements for an agency to provide or arrange for the provision of services to any unmarried minor female who is adjudicated abused, neglected or dependent and is pregnant or has delivered a child. This rule has been amended to format the rule for clarity and minor grammatical changes

were made. This rule is being proposed for amendment to adhere to the five year rule review process.

OAC 5101:2-42-71 entitled <u>Approval of Adult-Supervised Living Arrangements</u> sets forth the requirements for a licensed or certified adult supervised living arrangement to provide for pregnant minors, unmarried minor parent or the child of a minor parent. Further requirements are to investigate any complaint received on an adult-supervised living arrangement that the agency has approved and arrive at a determination to continue approval, revoke the approval for the setting, or initiate a corrective action plan. This rule has been amended to format the rule for clarity and minor grammatical changes were made. This rule is being proposed for amendment to adhere to the five year rule review process.

OAC 5101:2-42-93 entitled <u>Procedural Requirements Regarding Change of Placement or</u> <u>Visitation Plan Prior to Journalization of Case Plan</u> sets forth the requirements on obtaining a change in a court appointed placement. This rule has been amended to format the rule for clarity and minor grammatical changes were made. This rule is being proposed for amendment to adhere to the five year rule review process.
