Pursuant to sections 5101.60 and 5101.71 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon. The rule has been reviewed through the Partnership for Ohio's Families (PFOF) Rule Review initiative. The rule is a product of the collaborative partnership between ODJFS, public children services agencies (PCSA) and child welfare partners. The presenting rule language was developed through the Monitoring, Administration, SACWIS and Documentation Rule Review Team and approved by the PFOF Rule Review Coordination Board.

OAC rule **5101:2-33-02** entitled **Public Children Services Agency Requirement to Participate in Child Protection Oversight and Evaluation** addresses the continuous quality improvement process. Language has been modified for clarity and to specify the distinct processes of submitting an addendum or appealing the CPOE final report.
