Pursuant to sections 5101.35, 5153.16, 5153.163 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules identified below and of a public hearing thereon. These rules are being amended as a result of the Five Year Rule Review and recent policy updates, and the result of Partners for Ohio's Families (PFOF).

OAC rule 5101:2-33-03 entitled "Procedure for complaints of alleged discriminatory acts, policies or practices in the foster care or adoption process that involve race, color or national origin" has been amended to add the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services Bureau of Civil Rights (ODJFS-BCR) to the rule. The revision date on the JFS 02333 "Discrimination Complaint Form" (rev. 1/2015) was updated, and the reference to rule 5101:2-33-04 was removed, due to the rescission of the rule.

OAC rule 5101:2-33-11 entitled "Multiethnic Placement Act (MEPA) agency administrative requirements" has been amended to update the JFS 01420 "Multiethnic Placement Act Corrective Action and Resolution Plan Data Collection Requirements" (rev. 11/2014) and require PCSAs and PCPAs operating an adoption program to submit the JFS 01420 "Multiethnic Placement Act Corrective Action and Resolution Plan Data Collection Requirements" (rev. 11/2014) by March first of every even numbered year. The revision dates of the JFS 1688 "Individualized Child Assessment" (rev. 4/2014) and the JFS 1668 "MEPA Biennial Comprehensive Self-Assessment Report" (rev. 1/2014) were updated.
